***AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF USED
PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FORMERLY INSTALLED IN ROBERT ALLEN PARK
AND CURRENTLY INSTALLED IN LIMBRUNNER PARK***

WHEREAS, it is no longer necessary, useful to, or in the best interest of the City of Park City to retain ownership of used playground equipment formerly installed in Robert Allen Park and currently installed in Limbrunner Park; and

WHEREAS, such park equipment is outdated, and out of compliance with safety codes for playground equipment for children, and such playground equipment is no longer serviceable for public use, and has little or no value whatsoever; and

WHEREAS, such playground equipment constitutes surplus property of the City of Park City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Park City is a home rule municipality duly organized and operating under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6 of Article 7 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, the City of Park City has home rule authority to dispose of surplus property no longer needed by the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK CITY, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: That the preceding "Whereas" clauses are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance as if they were fully set forth herein.

SECTION II: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of, by any means he sees fit, all of the playground equipment formerly installed in Robert Allen Park and all of the playground equipment currently installed in Limbrunner Park at the time of the passage of this ordinance, and is directed to deposit any proceeds from the disposal of such playground equipment into the City treasury.

SECTION III: Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action arising, acquired or existing under any act or ordinance or portion thereof hereby repealed or amended by this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right, claim, penalty or remedy of any character of the corporate authority existing on the effective date hereof be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION V: If any provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this ordinance or application thereof to any person, firm, corporation, public agency or circumstance, shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, said judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons, firms, corporation, or circumstances, but shall be confined in its operation to the provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and to the person, firm, corporation, or circumstances involved. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of the City Council of the City of Park City that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional or invalid provision, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part thereof not been included.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
