General Provisions

1. Project to be constructed per drawings approved by the City of Park City.
2. A copy of this permit must be present at the project site at all times.
3. The applicant shall be responsible for acquiring permits from other agencies, when applicable, and this permit is not effective and work will be prohibited until those permits are obtained.
4. The applicant is responsible for providing a minimum of 48 hours notice to The City of Park City prior to inspection.
5. Before starting any excavation the applicant shall call J.U.L.I.E. at (800)892-0123 for field locations of buried utilities. The applicant shall be responsible for the protection of all existing underground and surface utilities. The applicant shall coordinate with utility companies to schedule adjustments to utility structures, if necessary.
6. The applicant shall be responsible for the notification of all emergency services, school districts, Lake County and IDOT's communication centers and other agencies affected by the project.
7. No work shall be permitted on Sunday, Saturday or on City Holidays, or between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., except in the case of an emergency and then only upon notification and approval of the City Engineer.
8. Roadways must remain open to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Property owners and residents along the project limits shall have the right to safe ingress and egress at all times. Traffic control and construction signage shall be installed and maintained in accordance with the latest issue of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). A traffic control plan, to include the construction haul route on City-owned streets, and approved by the City Engineer, must be on site at all times.
9. The applicant shall comply with the Illinois Department of Transportation's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, current edition. Where any conflicts exist the City Engineer shall be the sole judge as to the prevailing requirements.
10. The applicant shall take measures to ensure that excavated material and debris does not enter any of the City's facilities (including but not limited to sanitary and storm sewers, valve vaults and boxes). The construction site and roadways shall be maintained in a clean, driveable condition as determined by the City of Park City.

11. The City of Park City hereby reserves the right to order the change of location or the removal of any structure or structures authorized by the Permit, at any time, said changes or removal to be made at the sole expense of the applicant to whom the Permit is issued, or their successors and assigns.
12. The applicant shall be held responsible for loss or injury to persons or property where his work is involved, and shall provide such security and take such precautionary measures as deemed necessary to protect both his and the City of Park City's interests.
13. In accepting this permit, the applicant, his successors or assigns, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless The City of Park City, including its employees and officials, from all claims, actions or damages of every kind and description which may accrue to or be suffered by any person or persons, corporation or property by reason of the performance of any such work, character of materials used or manner of installation, maintenance and operation, or by the improper occupancy of rights-of-way and public place or public facility, and in this case any suit or action is brought against The City of Park City for damages arising out of or by reason of any of the aforementioned causes, the applicant, his successor or assigns will upon notice to him or them of commencement of such action, defend the same at his or their own sole cost and expense and will satisfy judgment after the said suit or action shall have finally been determined if adverse to The City of Park City.
14. Applicable surety and permit fees must be provided before issuance of permit. This permit will expire if no work has commenced within 180 days of permit issuance.
15. The City of Park City may revoke, annul, change, amend, amplify, or terminate the Permit or any of the conditions herein enumerated if applicant fails to comply with any or all of its provisions, special conditions, requirements or regulations as herein set forth or through willful or unreasonable neglect, fails to heed or comply with the notices given or if the work herein granted is not installed or operated and maintained in conformity herewith or et al or for any cause or reason whatsoever.
